Subject: Mandatory Update of Insurance, CIP, and COR

SUSPENSE DATE: SEPTEMBER 21, 2007

Mandatory Update of Certificates of Cargo Liability Insurance, Certificates of Responsibility (COR) and Certificates of Independent Pricing (CIP)

Effective immediately, all Transportation Service Providers (TSPs) must have their insurance representatives update all Certificates of Cargo Liability Insurance. The TSPs are responsible for their insurance company's submission of certificates by the deadline above.

Please have your insurance representatives file updated Mobile Home/Boat, Domestic and/or International insurance certificates, (whichever program you have Department of Defense (DOD) approval) within PPQWEB. PPQWEB is the only acceptable means for submitting the required documentation. SDDC also is requiring TSPs to submit updated/edited CIPs and CORs within PPQWEB, during this same period.

The submission of insurance certificates is necessary due to the implementation of Full Replacement Value (FRV) in the current program. FRV in the current program was announced in Federal Register Notice Volume 71, Number 241, dated December 15, 2006. The increase in insurance "amount per shipment" is to bring FRV into the current program as directed by the DOD. SDDC also requires at this time, that you update/edit your CIP and COR within PPQWEB. The insurance is increased to \$50,000 amount per shipment.

The updates must be submitted via PPQWEB no later than September 21, 2007. Failure to submit the updated insurance certificates AND CIPs, CORs shall result in your DOD approval/approvals being revoked.
