

CUSTOMS REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION FOR IMPORTS

HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS

Documents Required

- Passport
- Original Bill of Lading (OBL) / Air Waybill (AWB)
- Detailed inventory
- Certificate of Residence

Specific Information

- Shippers having lived abroad for at least 6 months prior to import may qualify for a duty exemption.

MOTOR VEHICLES

Documents Required

- Title / Registration
- Proof of insurance (must state the beginning and ending dates of the policy)
- OBL / AWB

Specific Information

- Shippers must have lived abroad for at least 1 year to import a motor vehicle duty free.
- The motorized vehicle (autos and motorcycles) must have been in the possession and used for at least 1 year prior to import.

PETS

Documents Required

- Vaccination Record
- Veterinary Health Certificate
- Pet Passport in Dutch or English

Specific Information

- Documents must accompany pets during travel.
- Pets must comply with all health regulations and have been vaccinated at least 30 days but less than 1 year prior to import.

RESTRICTED / DUTIABLE ITEMS

- New items (dutable)

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Drugs and narcotics

CURACAO

CONSIGNMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Recommended: Contact the destination agent to ensure all requirements have been met prior to import, especially for differences regarding air / sea shipments.
